

## REGULATIONS FOR THE LIBRARY COMMITTEE

[Unofficial translation]

### § 1 **Members of the Library Committee**

The Library Committee consists of the librarian, who is the chair of the committee, the assistant librarian, and six elected members.

The Nation's Antikvarie and Archivist are co-opted to the committees meeting by default. The Library Committee can invite other members of the Nation that show interest in the library's activities. Invited members have to be co-opted to the meetings.

### § 2 **Duties**

The Library Committee shall

- man the library during the decided opening hours,
- together with the librarian decide on the opening hours,
- after having asked for Bibliotekariekonventets opinion decide on which subjects the Nation shall supply course literature,
- make sure that the collections in the library are well kept,
- decide on activities for the committees work days,
- make sure to take care of the Nation's books and magazines within the committees area of responsibility.

### § 3 **Meeting minutes**

Minutes are to be kept for decisions regarding the opening hours, course as well as fictional literature, budgeted funds, and other matters that concerns the activities of the Library Committee.

### § 4 **Disposal**

Disposal of books are allowed only when the First Curator or the board of the Nation have approved it. Magazines can be disposed of after two years without approval from the First Curator or the board of the Nation.

### § 5 **Other regulations**

Apart from these regulations, the Library Committee are to follow what is otherwise declared about the committees of the Nation.
