INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING IN SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS

- A certificate showing study results from Uppdok/Ladok must **always be attached to every application**. Studies at other universities and university colleges may be accessed via so-called national certificates.
- All copies must be attested by two people, with name and telephone number. All attachments apart from study results from Uppdok/Ladok with original signature or with a control code must be attested. Printouts from "antagning.se" are not valid as certificates.
- Special eligibility for a scholarship must be documented in appendices (upper-secondary grades, civic registration certificate, etc.). If such
- False information in your application may entail repayment of scholarships received and in certain cases criminal liability.
- **Don't forget to sign your application! Unsigned applications are not valid.**

1. Fill in the name of the scholarships at the nation you wish to apply for.
2. Civic registration number (10 digits), the faculty you are enrolled in (theol, medicine, law, soc. sci., history-philosophy, languages, sci-tech., pharm., or educ. sci. fac.).
3. State the address to which you would like to have information regarding a possible scholarship award sent (notice is sent out in December for autumn scholarships and in June for spring scholarships). Please note - only those receiving scholarships will be notified.
4. Provide the place, parish, county and province where you were registered as a newborn.
5. State when/where your upper-secondary certificate was completed, or if you became eligible for university studies by completing education equivalent to an upper-secondary diploma.
6. State when you started your studies at Uppsala University and/or other universities; if more than one, state the first one..
 7. Higher education credits (HEC) at Swedish universities or university colleges are stated here. The credits for the grades VG, 5 and 4, AB and BA and A and B, respectively, must be stated if you have any of those grades.
8. If you have been admitted to a third-level (research) programme, fill in the estimated time for your licentiate/doctorate and your specialization. If you have not been admitted to a third-level programme, you should leave these fields blank. Fully funded PhD students are not eligible to apply for scholarships at Uplands nation.
9. If you have studied at other universities abroad, indicate this under "Other study qualifications." Any other study qualifications of importance should also be stated here.
10. Fill in **all** interruptions that have occurred since the beginning of your studies, such as work, parental leave, illness, military service. If you take a pause in your programme to study freestanding courses full time, that does not count as an interruption. State interruptions between studies at different universities. If you have been studying part time, state to what extent.
11. State here any special conditions that may be of importance to your evaluation for a scholarship. Kinship must be certified with a family tree.
12. It's important that you fill in **every field** under "Economic information". If you do not have any assets, or income, fill in a zero, do **not** leave the field blank.
 13. State here any family or economic conditions that may be of importance to your evaluation for a scholarship.
14. State what scholarships you have at Uppsala University/the nation. There is a scholarship limit which stipulates that a student may not have multiple minor scholarships totaling an amount that exceeds the scholarship limit (see current scholarship announcement).
15. State the bank account to which any awarded scholarships should be payed.
